

The GTEP Fellowship Program for Outstanding Post-Doctoral Fellows in Energy for the year 2024

Background

As a leading sustainable energy research and education initiative, one of the goals of the Grand Technion Energy Program (GTEP) is to promote and strengthen energy related research.

GTEP seeks to support outstanding international Post-Doctoral fellows who are pursuing energy related research, focusing on green and sustainable energy, to conduct research at the Technion – Israel Institute of Technology.

Accordingly, GTEP has allotted a few fellowships, each totaling up to 60,000 NIS for one year. These fellowships are designated for researchers who received their PhD degree in the past five years and can start their fellowship **no later than October 2024**. The fellowships will be granted according to the candidates' academic suitability as well as their research topic. The fellowships will be bestowed for a period of one-year. GTEP's funding would not exceed 50% of the fellowship in each month. The hosting supervisor at the Technion is responsible for providing funding for the remaining fellowship amount up to the actual fellowship offered to the candidate. As is customary at the Technion, the overall salary to the Post-Doctoral fellow from various sources will not exceed 15,000 NIS per month.

Instructions for submitting proposals:

- The attached Candidate Application Form must be submitted to GTEP, along with the candidate's CV and list of publications. The journal's impact factor must be stated next to each publication.
- Appendices must be submitted as detailed in the Application Form, including
 a summary of the candidate's research plan in Israel up to two pages.
 Focus will be placed on collaboration between the candidate and the supervisor.





- 3. Summary of the candidate's doctoral dissertation (up to one page).
- 4. Three recommendation letters.
- 5. A letter of undertaking from the supervisor at the Technion. Letters which provide detailed and well-reasoned arguments will increase the chance of the candidate's application being accepted.
- 6. All documents must be submitted by the Technion host in one PDF file.

The deadline for submitting applications is **June 10th**, **2024**. Applications must be submitted by email to the Grand Technion Energy Program office: galitk@technion.ac.il
